



MASTER SITE PLANS

Through our work with a site development specialist, we have created a long range master plan to guide our growth into the future. It will take over 11 Million Dollars to complete everything proposed on the site plan. The Camp Sonshine Board of Directors has selected what it believes to be the most pressing and important projects for the first phase of this multi-year endeavor.

MASTER SITE PLAN: PHASE 1 - \$3.9 MILLION

1A - Sonshine Recreation Center: Will provide solutions for current and future needs of camp, including gym, additional activity areas, meeting space, weather shelter and more.

1B – Camper Lodge at Solaris: Additional housing for summer campers and year round user group guests.
